*The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm with the majority of the meeting spent reviewing principal's report results of the Fall Parent Survey.*

**Reports:**

Principal- Michael Taylor: A 3 page written summary of the *Parent Survey 2009* was distributed for review to all members.

Bernadette Gauss- President: Issues relating to the Annual Fund were discussed with focus on questions or inquires relating to corporate donations or matching funds being directed to our school versus the parish.

Pastor- Fr. Jerry Herda, not present, no report submitted.

Dan Galligan- VP & Finance Committee: 5K run discussed briefly with progress reported towards WAC sponsorship and possible joint planning with St. Monica folks. All other details are being researched.

Parish Liaison – Kristy Drehobl: Kristy attended a St. Monica parish council meeting lead by Fr. Jerry Herda which focused on identifying specific signs within a “Vibrant Parish”. Kristy reports this discussion was fruitful and worthwhile in helping parish council members think about how to get more people involved with active ministry and parish life.
